Thank you for requesting the comments of the Division for Historic Preservation of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include potential environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project. Such impacts must be considered as part of the environmental review of the project pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6NYCRR Part 617).

Adjacent to the proposed project are three properties that are eligible for listing in the State and National Registers of Historic Places -the Auriesville Cemetery, a residence and New World Dutch barn at 129 Valley View Road and Our Lady of Martyrs Shrine. Our office has reviewed the proposed solar project. Based upon our review, it is the OPRHP's opinion that the project will have No Adverse Impact on historic or archaeological resources, provided the following conditions can be met:

- A vegetative buffer must be retained between the Auriesville Cemetery and the proposed access road and solar panel installation.
- If this condition cannot be met or if there are substantive changes to the project, consultation with our office should resume.
